Dispensational Theology

"A dispensation is a distinguishable economy in the outworking of God's purpose."

The Greek word *oikonomia* comes from the verb that means to manage, regulate, administer, and plan. The word itself is a compound whose parts mean literally "to divide, apportion, administer or manage the affairs of an inhabited house."

Dispensations Recognized by the Apostle Paul

Past ages – Prior to the Church

• Colossians 1:25-26 -Of this church I was made a minister according to the stewardship from God bestowed on me for your benefit, so that I might fully carry out the preaching of the word of God, that is, the mystery which has been hidden from the **past ages** and generations, but has now been manifested to His saints,

The Church – The stewardship of God's grace

• Ephesians 3:1-3 - For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles if indeed you have heard of the **stewardship of God's grace** which was given to me for you; that by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief.

The Kingdom – The fullness of the times

• Ephesians 1:9-10 - He made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His kind intention which He purposed in Him with a view to an administration suitable to **the fullness of the times**, that is, the summing up of all things in Christ, things in the heavens and things on the earth.

Common throughout all Dispensations

History is from the viewpoint of God.

Clear time when one ends and another begins but allowing for transition.

God is moving everything in His ordained direction.

New revelation designates shift from one dispensation to another.

Some things remain the same but other things differ. Salvation always by faith.

Each has own responsibilities and tests.

Each dispensation moves God's plan closer to completion.

Review of past lessons

Angels - Nature and Attributes

Spirit beings

• Reveal in the form of human bodies (Gen. 18:3), "spirits" (Heb. 1:14), no marriage (Mark 12:25) no death (Luke 20:36).

Created beings

• The Lord created the angels by His word (Ps. 148:2–5). Angels sang praise (Job 38:6–7). Christ created (Col. 1:16).

Created simultaneously and are innumerable in number

• Singular act (Col 1:16); no reproducing (Matt. 22:30), "myriads" (Heb. 12:22), "countless thousands" (cf. Rev. 5:11).

Higher order than man

• Mankind, is "lower than the angels" (Heb. 2:7). No death (Luke 20:36). greater wisdom (2 Sam. 14:20), yet limited (Matt. 24:36). Greater power (Matt. 28:2; Acts 5:19; 2 Pet. 2:11), yet limited (Dan. 10:13).

Angels - Prominent Individuals

Michael

• Michael (Dan. 10:13; 12:1; Jude 9). The name Michael means "who is like God?" and identifies the only one classified as an archangel in Scripture. Michael is the defender of Israel who will wage war on behalf of Israel against Satan and his hordes in the Tribulation (Rev. 12:7–9). Michael also disputed with Satan about the body of Moses, but Michael refrained from judgment, leaving that to God (Jude 9).

Gabriel

• Gabriel (Dan. 9:21; Luke 1:26). His name means "man of God" or "God is strong." Gabriel explained the events of the seventy weeks for Israel (Dan. 9:21–27). In Luke 1:26–27 Gabriel told Mary that the One born to her would be great and rule on the throne of David. In Daniel 8:15–16 Gabriel explained to Daniel the succeeding kingdoms of Medo-Persia and Greece. Gabriel also announced the birth of John the Baptist to Zacharias (Luke 1:11–20).

Lucifer

• Lucifer (Isa. 14:12) means "shining one" or "star of the morning." He may have been the wisest and most beautiful of all God's created beings who was originally placed in a position of authority over the cherubim surrounding the throne of God.

Review of past lessons

Angels - Divine Attendants

Cherubim

 Cherubim are "of the highest order or class, created with indescribable powers and beauty. Proclaimers and protectors of God's glorious presence, His sovereignty, and His holiness. They stood guard at the gate of the Garden of Eden (Gen. 3:24); Golden figures covering the mercy seat (Exod. 25:17–22); Attended the glory of God in Ezekiel's vision (Ezek. 1). Extraordinary appearance with four faces—that of a man, lion, ox, and eagle. They have four wings and feet like a calf, gleaming like burnished bronze. In Ezekiel 1 they attended the glory of God preparatory for judgment.

Seraphim

• Seraphim, meaning "burning ones," are pictured surrounding the throne of God in Isaiah 6:2. They are described as each having six wings. In their threefold proclamation, "holy, holy, holy" (Isa. 6:3), it means "to recognize God as extremely, perfectly holy. Therefore, they praise and proclaim the perfect holiness of God. The seraphim also express the holiness of God in that they proclaim that man must be cleansed of sin's moral defilement before he can stand before God and serve Him."

Fallen Purpose Angels Promote Satan's program in opposing God by promoting rebellion, idolatry, false religions, and oppression of mankind.

Relation to Believers Wage war, accuse, plant doubt, tempt to sin, persecute, prevent service, disturb the church.

Destiny

Defeated by Christ and will be cast into the abyss during Millennium and cast into lake of fire as final punishment

Review of past lessons

Faithful Purpose Angels To serve God in worship, in ministry, in being God's messengers, to act in God's government, protecting God's people, and executing God's judgment.

Relation to Believers Reveal truth, guide, provide physical needs, protect, deliver, encourage, act in answering prayer, accompany the dead.

Destiny

To be in God's presence and Christ's presence in His kingdom.

Review of past lessons

Satan – Past and Future

Satan fell from his original exalted position.	As the anointed cherub Satan led a host of angels, possibly one-third of all the angels, from heaven in his fall (Ezek. 28:16–17; Rev. 12:4).
Satan's ultimate defeat was pronounced in Eden.	God informed Satan that he would have a minor victory ("you shall bruise him on the heel"), but Christ would have a major victory through the cross ("He shall bruise you on the head" Gen. 3:15).
Satan was rendered powerless through the cross.	Christ partook of humanity, and through His substitutionary death He defeated Satan, rendering him impotent in the believer's life. Satan had the power of death over people but that power was broken through Christ (Heb. 2:14).
Satan will be cast out of heaven during the Tribulation.	The casting out of heaven (Rev. 12:13) is an act of judgment and probably refers to the stellar heavens, also known as the second heaven (not the presence of God).
Satan will be bound in the pit for 1,000 years.	At the triumphant return of Christ, Satan is bound for 1,000 years and shut up in the abyss, no longer able to deceive anyone on earth for the duration of the Millennium (Rev. 20:2–3).
Satan will finally be cast into the lake of fire.	At the end of the Millennium, Satan is released whereupon he deceives many people, leads a rebellion against God, is defeated and finally cast into the lake of fire for eternity (Rev. 20:7–10).

Satan – Present activities

Satan binds the lost (Matt 13:19; Mark 4:15; Luke 8:12; 2 Cor 4:4)

- Through counterfeit religions that mimic true faith: By false doctrines (1 Tim 4:1), By false ministers (Matt 7:15, 21-23; 2 Cor 11:13-15), By false Christ's (Matt 24:23-24; 1 John 2:18, 22; 4:3), By false followers (Matt 13:25, 36-39), By a false, complicated, and perverted gospel (2 Cor 11:3-4; Gal 1:8), By false religions (Matt 12:27; Rev 2:9)
- Through religions and philosophies that are openly anti-Christian: By materialism, the lust of the eyes (John 13:2, 27), By hedonism, the lust of the flesh (Eph 2:1-3; John 3:19-20), By spiritism: Direct devil worship (Lev 19:31; 20:6, 27; Deut 18:9-12), Idolatry (Deut 32:16-17; Ps 106:36-37), Self worship, humanism (1 Sam 15:23)

Satan – Present activities (cont.)

Satan opposes God's people (Matt 16:23; 2 Cor 2:11; Eph 6:11-12)

- Satan opposes believers through temptation (Matt 4:1; 1 Thes 3:5): Temptation to materialism (Matt 6:24; 1 John 2:15-17), Temptation to immorality (1 Cor 7:5), Temptation to pride and self-sufficiency (1 Chr 21:1; 1 Tim 3:6), Temptation to lie (John 8:44; Acts 5:3), Temptation to doubt (Gen 3:1-5)
- Satan opposes believers through divisions (Eph 4:26-27; James 3:14-16)
- Satan opposes believers by accusing them (Luke 22:31-32; 1 Pet 5:7-9)
- Satan opposes by trying to destroy Christian leaders (1 Chr 21:1; 1 Tim 3:7)
- Satan opposes by mixing unbelievers in church (Matt 7:15; Acts 20:29)
- Satan can oppose believers by causing physical problems (Job 2:7; 2 Cor 12:7)
- Satan can oppose thru civil govt. and persecution (Dan 10:10ff; Rev 2:10)
- Satan .. by lies (Jn 8:44), false miracles (2 Thes 2:9), and hindrances (1 Thes 2:18)

Mankind in Relation to Angelic Conflict

Satan attacked man's volition, which is focal point of man's character and the angelic conflict.

The failure of human volition mirrors the failure of the angelic volition prior to the rebellion.


Satan scored a tactical victory in the garden.

God knew Adam would fall and provided a grace plan.

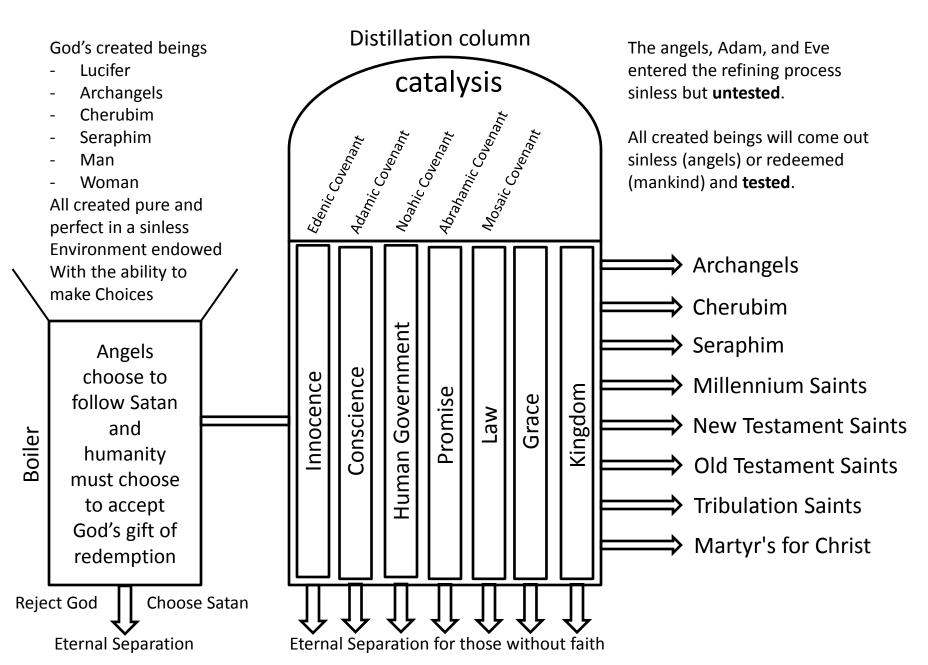
Satan's tactical victory sealed his defeat.

In man's fall, Adam violated: Personal love for God, Reversed the male/female roles that God had ordained, Rejected position as servant of God


As a result of fall, God is able to demonstrate His righteousness and justice and that it is compatible with His love that He demonstrated thru His grace.





God walked with man

- Genesis 2:15 Then the LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it.
- Genesis 3:8 They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day,

God spoke to man

• Genesis 2:16 - The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely;

God had fellowship with man

• Genesis 2:19 - Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the sky, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called a living creature, that was its name.

loss must be retrieved on the human level and in the realm of the will

•losses sustained by man must and can be retrieved only on the human level and within the realm of the will.

No other man to redeem man

•Had the Lord created another Adam, He would have made a duplicate, a precise copy of the first man, being like him, he would have yielded to temptation as Adam had done.

none of Adams descendants could redeem the race

• every creature produces after its own kind. This is an unvarying law. Man cannot lift himself by his own bootstraps. No man, therefore, is able to redeem his brother, himself, or anyone else.

No celestial creature could redeem the race

•Should a cherub, come into the human realm by virgin birth to champion man's cause ... could have passed into Sheol. But there he would have remained, because he would not have had the power to take the keys of death and Hades from Satan.

No other being is powerful enough to redeem man


 God, figuratively speaking, had a pattern, according to which He created Satan. This pattern included the sum of all perfections which could be possessed by a created being.



Man's Responsibilities

 Man's responsibilities, having been ejected from the garden, was to fulfill the Adamic Covenant, essentially to multiply and fill the Earth. Mankind was to respond to God through the prompting of his conscience and as evidence of his faith in the promised seed, to bring an acceptable blood sacrifice as God had instructed them to do.

Man's Failures

 Mankind, having been given the ability, through their conscience, to desire a relationship with God and the provision, through blood sacrifices, to approach God, failed to due so and instead followed after their own evil lusts. The wickedness and evil became so great and widespread, God decided to let mankind start anew.

The Resulting Judgment

• God, being true to His word, spared the only faithful humans and a small remnant of air breathing creatures and started over in order to fulfill his promise of redemption




Approaching God in the Dispensation of Conscience

Approach God by Faith

• Hebrews 11:4 - By faith Abel offered to God a better sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained the testimony that he was righteous, God testifying about his gifts, and through faith, though he is dead, he still speaks.

Blood sacrifice as example of faith

- The test then becomes "with a conscience, guided by that conscience, will man choose to do good and approach God by means of sacrifice as the example of the sacrifice that God indicated".
- Leviticus 17:11 'For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.'



At The End Of The Second Economy

Promise of Redemption Maintained - Genesis 6:8-9, 18; 7:1

- But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD. These are the records of the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his time; Noah walked with God.
- "But I will establish My covenant with you; and you shall enter the ark—you and your sons and your wife, and your sons' wives with you.
- Then the LORD said to Noah, "Enter the ark, you and all your household, for you alone I have seen to be righteous before Me in this time.





Dispensation of Human Government (Genesis 9:1 to 11:32)

Man's Responsibilities


• Man's responsibilities were to fulfill the Noahic covenant. Mankind was to be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth. Mankind was to govern itself with the full authority of capitol punishment.

Man's Failures

• Failure to govern successfully appeared on the scene almost immediately, for Noah became drunk and incapable of ruling. The people, instead of obeying God's command to scatter and fill the earth, conceived the idea of staying together and building the tower of Babel to help achieve their aim. Fellowship with man replaced fellowship with God.

The Resulting Judgment

• As a result, God sent the judgment of the tower of Babel and the confusion of languages. He also graciously intervened in that He did not utterly destroy the nations but chose to deal graciously with Abraham and his descendants.



Small Remnant of Righteous – The Example of Job's Theology

God's sovereignty – Job 1:21

He said, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked I shall return there. The LORD gave and the LORD has taken away. Blessed be the name of the LORD."

God's justice – Job 13:15–16

 "Though He slay me, I will hope in Him. Nevertheless I will argue my ways before Him.
 "This also will be my salvation, For a godless man may not come before His presence.

God's promise of salvation – Job 19:25

• "As for me, I know that **my Redeemer lives**, And at the last **He will take His stand on the earth**.

Dispensation of Promise (Genesis 11:10 to Exodus 18:27)

Man's Responsibilities

• The responsibility of the patriarchs was simply to believe and serve God, and God gave them every material and spiritual provision to encourage them to do this. The Promised Land was theirs, and blessing was theirs as long as they remained in the land. The people of the promise; Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and the children of Jacob (Israel) were to stay separate from the nations around them.

Man's Failures

• Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and his twelve sons continued to intermingle with the Canaanites and surrounding nations.

The Resulting Judgment

 God sent the family down to Egypt where the surrounding Egyptians would not associate with them.
 Soon after they would be enslaved.

Approach God by Faith

 Genesis 15:5–7 And He took him outside and said, "Now look toward the heavens, and count the stars, if you are able to count them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." Then he believed in the LORD; and He reckoned it to him as righteousness. And He said to him, "I am the LORD who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to possess it."





• The responsibility of the Nation of Israel along with Gentile proselytes was to keep the Mosaic Law.


Man's Failures

 The Nation of Israel was continually disobedient and God continued to bring them back through discipline. They continued to reject the ordinances of God. (2nd Kings 17:7-23)

The Resulting Judgment

 As a result, there were many judgments throughout this long period. The ten tribes were carried into Assyrian captivity; the two tribes were carried into Babylonian captivity; and later, because of their rejection of Jesus of Nazareth, the people were dispersed into all the world (Matt. 23:37–39).





When His hour finally did come, and when Yeshua was dying on the cross, Satan was no longer in control; rather, the Messiah was in total control. The cross, which brought salvation to humanity, brought judgment upon Satan."

Dispensation of Grace (Acts 2:1 to Revelation 19:21)

Man's Responsibilities

Under Grace the responsibility on man is to accept the gift of righteousness that God freely offers to all (Rom. 5:15–18). There are two aspects of the grace of God in this economy:

Man's Failures


Promise of Redemption Maintained

The context of 1 Peter strongly suggests indirect attacks of Satan through the cosmic system and not direct engagements with Satan and demons.

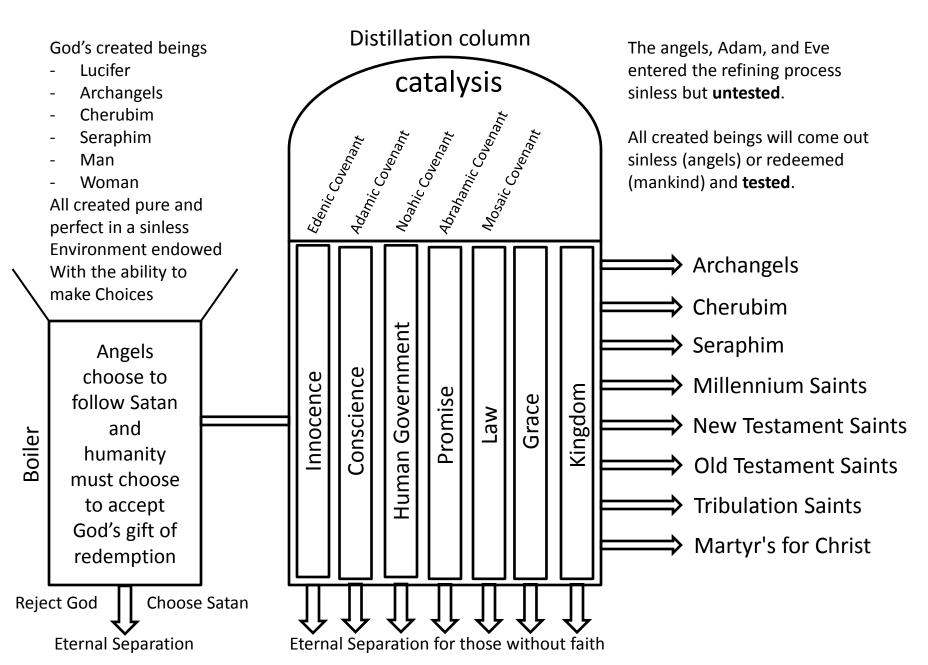
